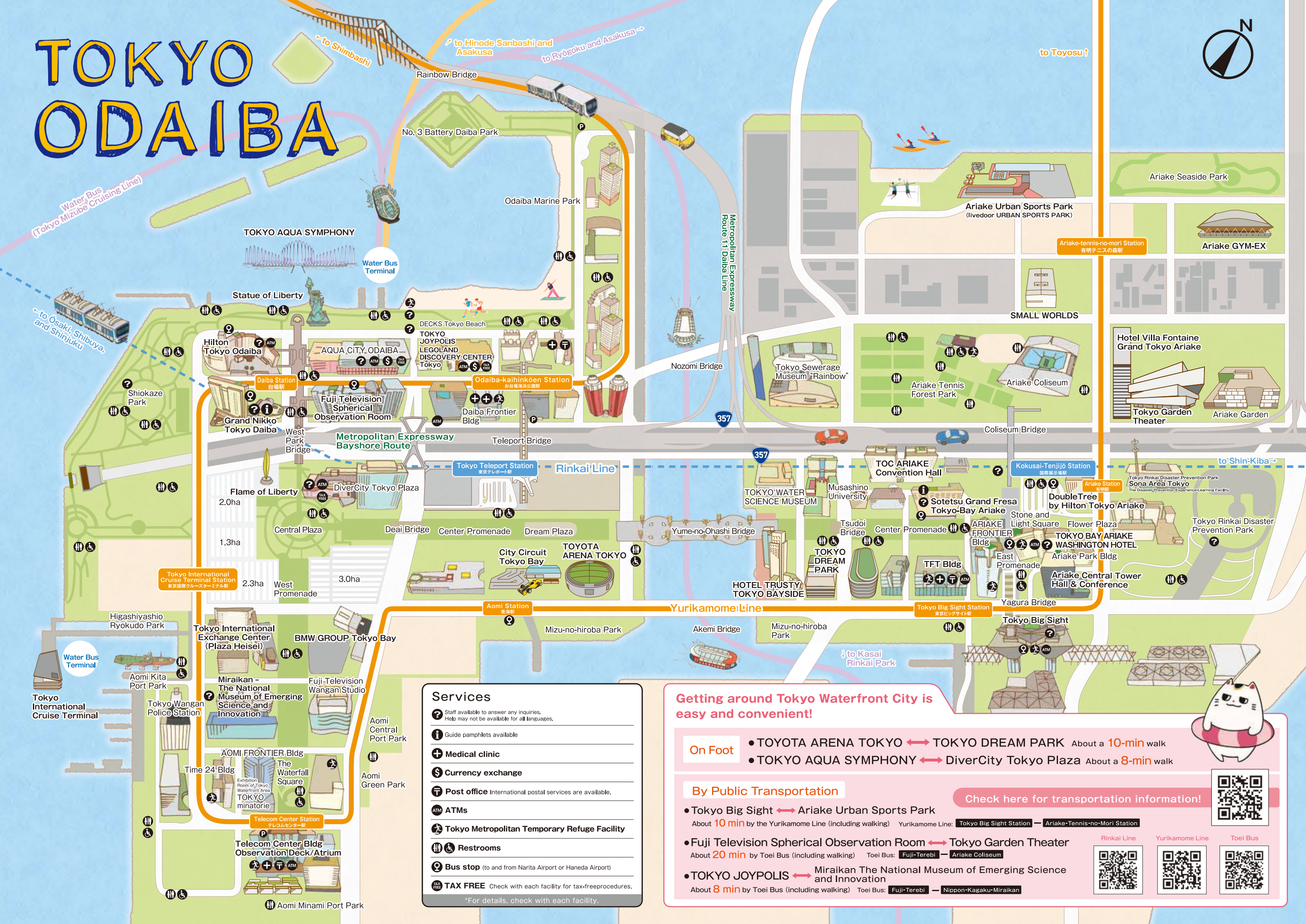

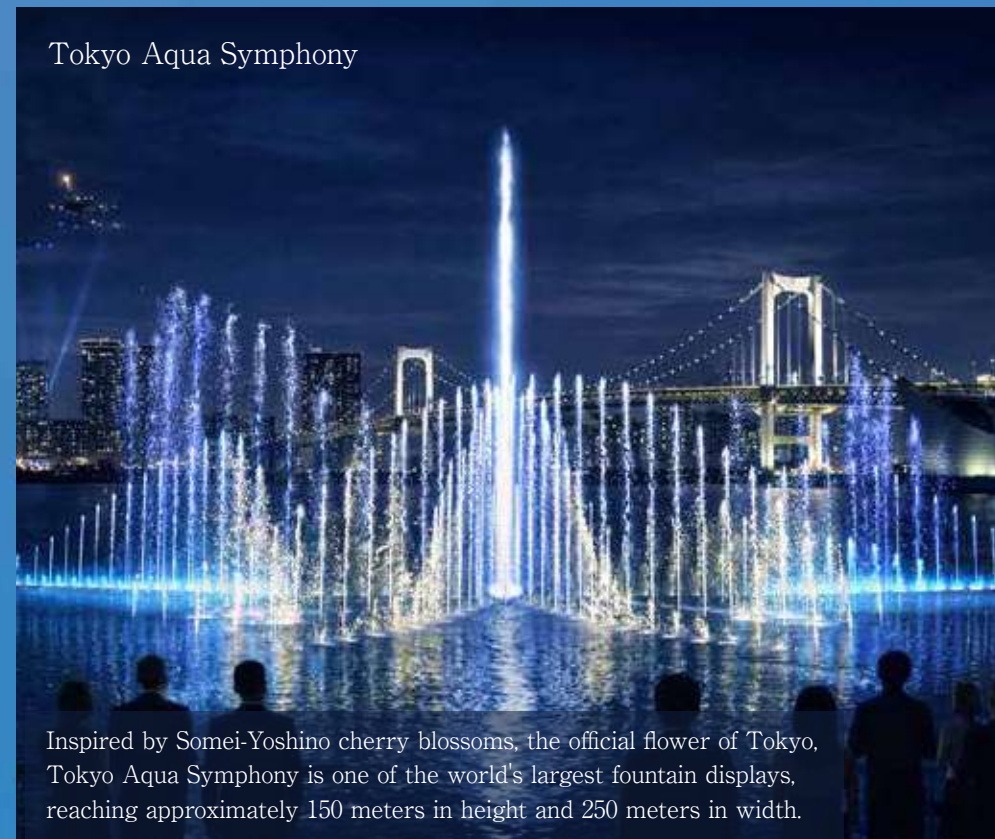

This area, connected by expansive parks, has been developed with a focus on a decarbonized society and the SDGs. With environmentally conscious infrastructure in place, the cityscape features an advanced urban design free of overhead utility poles and garbage collection vehicles.



Designed for Sustainable MICE

Urban infrastructure designed with sustainability in mind supports MICE events

In this area, infrastructure planning has been carried out in an integrated manner from the early stages of urban development. Through the consolidation of utilities within integrated underground tunnels that house multiple lifelines, an efficient transportation system centered on public transit, and environmentally conscious energy systems such as district heating and cooling, the area as a whole achieves both reduced environmental impact and operational stability. By functioning together, these urban infrastructure systems support a safe and sustainable environment for MICE events for both organizers and participants.

Comfortable stays supported by digital and urban infrastructure

To ensure that participants can stay and move around the area with ease, features such as free Wi-Fi and multilingual digital signage are well developed. This urban environment allows even first-time visitors to navigate the area without stress, contributing to the overall satisfaction of the event.

Environmentally conscious urban landscapes and spacious design

In this area, environmental considerations are reflected in the urban landscape through features such as streetscapes free of utility poles, efficient urban management supported by underground infrastructure, and spacious layouts surrounded by greenery and the waterfront. These open spaces and well-maintained streetscapes create an urban environment well suited to hosting MICE events that accommodate large numbers of participants.

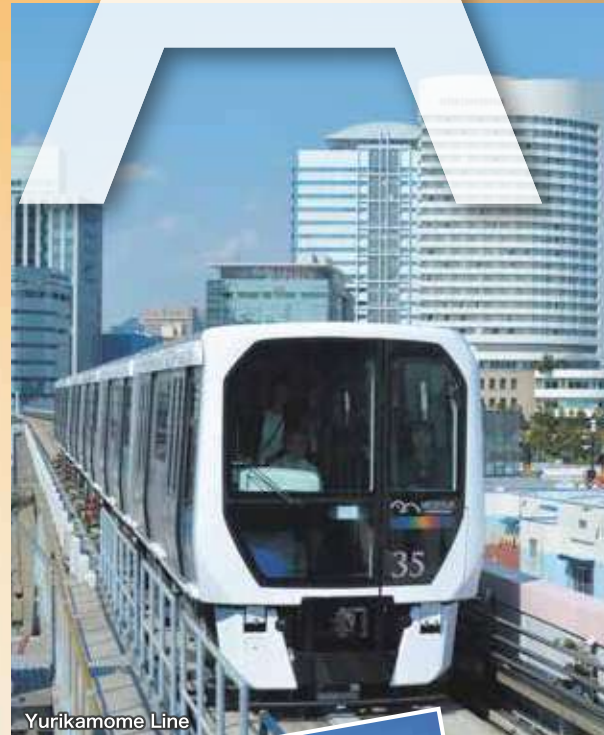

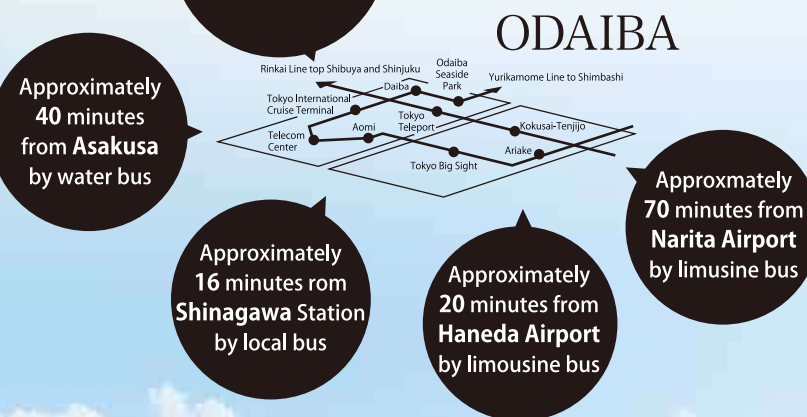

In addition to urban transportation such as the Yurikamome Line, the Rinkai Line, and Tokyo BRT, the area is also served by both Haneda and Narita airports, as well as maritime access via water buses and cruise ships.

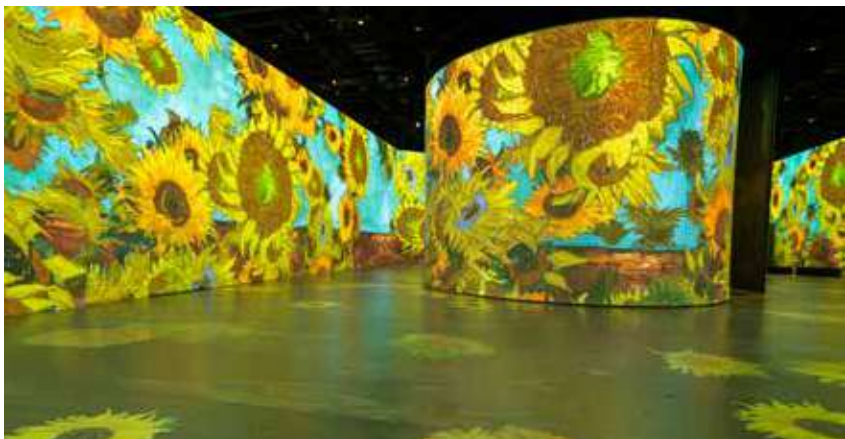
